

LIST OF DRUGS

Drugs to be stocked at STI Clinics and PHCs and CHCs providing RTI/STI Services

All clinics must maintain adequate stock of drugs required for treatment of STIs as per the standard protocol. Following is the inventory of essential STI treatment drugs. They should be stored in a secure location and used before their expiry date.

1. Inj. Benzathene Penicillin – 24 lakhs unit vial
2. Inj. Ceftriaxone (250 mg & 1 gm)
3. Tab. Azithromycin (1g)
4. Tab. Cefixime (400mg)
5. Tab. Fluconazole (150 mg)
6. Tab. Secnidazole (500 mg)
7. Tab Metronidazole (400 mg)
8. Tab. Erythromycin (500 mg) base/stearate
9. Cap. Doxycycline (100 mg)
10. Cap. Acyclovir (400 mg)
11. Clotrimazole Vaginal pessary (500 mg)
12. Podophyllin tincture 20%
13. Permethrin cream (5%) and (1%)
